2025: GRIEF INTO ACTION

Teen Leadership Program: *Switzerland*

Palestinian and Jewish Israeli teens joined a sixmonth journey of dialogue and leadership, culminating in a two-week intensive in the Alps.



86% of participants reported increased resilience, confidence, and shared values.

Alumni Leadership Summit: Santa Fe

Alumni deepened and learned diplomacy, public speaking, and moral imagination skills from teachers such as Monica Guzman from Braver Angels and visionary thought leader John Paul Lederach.

English for Leadership Program

This virtual eight-week course equipped young Palestinian women with English language skills and confidence to step into TW's more advanced programming.

Trauma Healing & Leadership: *Israel & West Bank*

Multiple cohorts of our young leaders are engaging in trauma-informed healing, dialogue, and non-violence seminars throughout 2025. So far, 93% report finding renewed purpose as changemakers.
